# **♦ Storage Size Guide – Version 1: Based on Living Space or Use Case**

This version helps customers choose a unit size based on the size of their home or a specific project, like decluttering a garage or attic.

Living Space or Project	Recommended Unit Size	What It Can Hold
Studio Apartment / Dorm Room	5' x 5' or 5' x 10'	Small furniture, boxes, clothes, dorm items, twin mattress, small appliances
1-Bedroom Apartment	10' x 10'	Queen bed, couch, dresser, coffee table, 10–20 boxes, kitchen appliances
2-Bedroom Apartment / Condo	10' x 15'	Two beds, dining table, sofa set, washer/dryer, 20–30 boxes, bikes
2-3 Bedroom House	10' x 20' or 10' x 25'	Full household items including appliances, bedroom furniture, garage contents
3–4 Bedroom House / Large Move	10' x 30' or warehouse	Complete home contents, outdoor furniture, full garage, large appliances
Garage or Attic Cleanup	5' x 10' or 10' x 10'	Tools, seasonal decorations, lawn equipment, totes, shelving units
Office or Small Business Storage	10' x 15' or 10' x 20'	Filing cabinets, inventory, workstations, retail racks, signage
RV / Boat (Uncovered)	10' x 22' or larger	Small trailers, jet skis, boats under 22 ft
RV / Boat (Covered)	12' x 30' to 12' x 60'	Full-size RVs, boats, trailers, with trickle charger and dump station access

# Storage Size Guide – Version 2: Based on Unit Size

This version starts with the unit size first and suggests common storage scenarios for each.

Unit Size	What It Fits
5' x 5'	Like a hall closet – boxes, seasonal décor, kids' toys, suitcases, small shelves
5' x 10'	Studio apartment – twin/full bed, dresser, small sofa, 10–15 boxes
10' x 10'	1-bedroom apartment – queen bed, couch, kitchen table, washer/dryer, 20 boxes
10' x 15'	2-bedroom apartment or office equipment – beds, appliances, desks, shelving
10' x 20'	2–3 bedroom house – full bedroom sets, appliances, patio furniture, large boxes
10' x 25'	Larger homes or major downsizing – everything from bedrooms to garage contents
10' x 30'	Full household or long-term storage – large appliances, multiple rooms, inventory
Warehouse Units	Commercial use, full relocations, long-term bulk storage
RV/Boat 10' x 22' (Uncovered)	Small trailers, fishing boats, pop-up campers
RV/Boat 12' x 30' to 12' x 60' (Covered)	Large RVs, boats, campers, includes trickle charger access
